# One Less Worry for Claudia

laudia and her husband welcomed their precious baby girl, Julia, in April. They were thrilled to add another daughter to their family, but giving birth during a global pandemic came with considerable stress. Claudia now must care for the little one while also managing online learning for her older children — Mateo, 5, and Natalie, 11.

Claudia's husband works in painting and construction, but his hours have been limited

since the pandemic. Jobs are fewer and farther between, and there's much more competition with so many people out of work.

Plus, the couple is always worried he may get sick. With an infant at home, contracting the virus is a real stressor.

"What if he gets sick and brings it home to us and the baby?" Claudia says. "But he has to work. He doesn't have a choice."

Fortunately, the family doesn't have to fret about how they'll afford food this holiday season. They recently learned about the One Gen Away Mobile Food Pantry with food provided by Second Harvest that visits Plaza Mariachi near their home in Nashville.



The need for our services grows more urgent as the pandemic continues to create hardship for our neighbors. "It's projected that 1 in 5 people (and 1 in 4 children) are now food-insecure as a result of COVID-19. That is why we are so thankful for your support.

Volunteers deliver fresh produce during a no-contact, drive-thru distribution in Crawford, Overton County. Hosted by 5 Loaves Food Pantry, this event usually serves 180 families. With recent COVID-19 closures and job losses, however, this Second Harvest Partner Agency now serves up to 350 families per distribution.



Brett sorts food donations at our Nashville warehouse. With social distancing measures in place, our capacity to host volunteers dropped from 100 to 25. Despite these limitations, volunteers continue to give thousands of hours to serve our communities.



Sheila and Zena visit the Caywood/First Pentecostal Church Mobile Pantry in Lexington, Henderson County. They are both on a fixed income and currently share a one-bedroom apartment. Sheila said, "COVID-19 is hard on folks. Food is to be cherished these days and shared." Volunteers from local schools and churches helped with the distribution, including the Lexington Police Department.



We met Ashley at Looby Community Center in Nashville, where 200 families receive food boxes every week through a partnership between Second Harvest and Metro Parks and Recreation. She is a nurse practitioner and the mother of three teenage children with special needs. When schools moved to online learning, she had to take a leave of absence from her job to care for them at home. Money is incredibly tight, but Ashley is doing what she can to maintain a sense of normalcy for the kids. "You start to see what is really important," she said. "This right here, people helping other people - people they don't know that's important."



Eric was a masonry worker in Mt. Pleasant until an injury forced him to leave his job. This visit to The Family Center at Maury Hills Church in Columbia is his first Mobile Pantry. He hopes the food he receives will help him make ends meet during a very tight month. Eric said, "I just love seeing all of the kind faces. It makes you feel welcome. You know someone cares and that means a lot when you are in a hard place."



Ivanka greets volunteers during a USDA Food Box Distribution at Glencliff High School in Nashville. Her family has never attended a food distribution before, but money is tight after her father's hours were cut. Ivanka and her siblings also received meals over the summer through several local feeding sites. Though Ivanka's big sister Kenay is only 12, she said, "I've thought, maybe I could get a job. Something to do to help."

# Career Educator **Finds New** Ways to Serve

he child of a pastor and a schoolteacher, Ernestine Wilson was taught that "anything we have can be a blessing to others." Now she gives her time to help feed those in need.

As a volunteer for Second Harvest since March. Ernestine has assembled BackPacks for children, packed commodity food boxes for seniors, directed traffic at drive-thru Mobile Pantry sites, and more.

She says volunteering looks different during the pandemic. Volunteers wear masks and practice nocontact food distribution. But despite the risks to their own health, volunteers give the same personal, compassionate service as always.

"When you give to others, you take the focus off of yourself," she says, which is an important reminder during a time when so

66 When you give to others. you take the focus off of yourself. 99 many are struggling. For Ernestine, volunteering with Second Harvest is about putting aside your own comfort to do something important for others.

Throughout her career as an educator in New Orleans and then in Nashville, she has seen firsthand the need for nutritious food during school and after, which is why she always kept a small food pantry in her room. "You never know what the children are dealing with at home," she says. "They don't always

know where their next meal is coming from."

The holidays are especially hard for families in need. Like many of us, Ernestine's holiday celebrations have always happened around a dinner table. Her mother cooks a large meal for her children, cousins, and neighbors that stop by. Volunteering with Second Harvest is one way to bring some of that holiday spirit to those struggling with hunger.

"I would suggest you go and give your time," she says. "There's nothing like that feeling."

e hear stories about how people across our country face serious financial challenges in the wake of COVID-19. But we also hear stories about how much your support is helping people like James.

James started his own landscaping business to support his family, including his wife, who has a disability that prevents her from working, and their two children, ages 11 and 12. But since the pandemic began, he's lost significant income.

We met Margaret and her sister Catherine at a drive-thru, no-contact food distribution at Spring Hill High School. Both women have retired after working more than 30 years at the GM plant in Spring Hill. Now in their golden years, the sisters are having a hard time affording their monthly expenses on fixed incomes.

"With COVID-19, food prices have really gone up," Catherine says. "This puts food on the table."

She's living in Antioch with her brother and his grandson and learned about The Well's Mobile Pantry from their church. Catherine says the food means she's able
